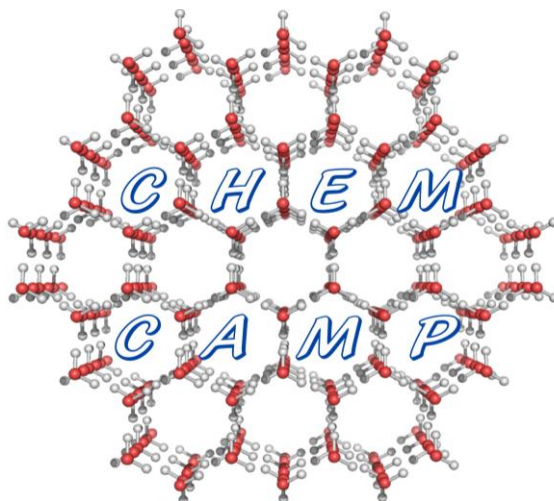


# Summer Science Camps in Madison!
